With the changes coming so rapidly in response to the COVID-19 outbreak, I'd like to recap where we stand in terms of school operations and after school activities. Scott County Central Schools will be closed beginning **Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 3**. All after school activities will also be cancelled during this time. We will be re-evaluating the situation throughout and making a final decision by April 3<sup>rd</sup> regarding our return date. Our hope is to return on **Monday, April 6**.

During the break, we'll be sending out activities and resources to keep our students as academically engaged as possible. Of course, this will be a challenge, but we ask for your help in encouraging your child to devote a little time each day to keeping those skills sharpened. Also, we remain committed to ensuring that all students receive breakfast and lunch every day, Monday through Friday, at no cost to our families. Our current plan is to deliver both breakfast and lunch to each designated bus stop between 8:00 and 9:00, beginning this Wednesday morning- March 18<sup>th</sup>. If you could have someone available to come out and pick up those meals during delivery times, that will help the process move much more smoothly.

We understand the burden this puts on parents and caregivers in our community and sincerely hope this break is short lived. We'll continue to do all we can to serve our students and families during this time, while making health and safety a number one priority.
